With the vehicles on our roads making up around 20% of the UK's greenhouse gas emissions, expanding Scotland's EV charging network is a priority.

Our Net Zero Transport team is working with Transport Scotland to assist local authorities expand their EV charging networks.

Attracting private sector investment is key to bringing about this transition, and our team has developed guidance and templates based on a 'concession' type contract which are all available on our [website](#).
